

HOLD ST. JAMES OF SAG BRIDGE OUTING TODAY

St. James Catholic church of Sag Bridge, near Lemont, will hold its annual "first Sunday in August" picnic and dinner today in the parish grove.

Women of the parish will serve dinner immediately after the noon mass. Arrangements are in charge of the Rev. William R. Leyhane, pastor. The church, was

founded in 1833 and is said to be the oldest standing Catholic structure in the Chicago archdiocese.

A quaint stone block structure, the church long has been a favorite subject of artists and photographers. The event will serve as a reunion of the Pa-Ly-Le-Or, an old parish society. It also will mark completion of volunteer work by parish men on parking lots and roads leading to the church and thru the parish cemetery.
